

 incorrectly!






Percentage of the Final Written Decisions




Joined and dismissed cases are excluded.

In re: Myriad

In their 2013 case, the Supreme Court states:

"We have "long held that this provision contains an important implicit exception[:] Laws of nature, natural phenomena, and abstract ideas are not patentable." Mayo, 566 U. S., at ____ (slip op., at 1) (internal quotation marks and brackets omitted). Rather, "they are the basic tools of scientific and technological work" that lie beyond the domain of patent protection."

The Supreme Court didn't CREATE law in 2013, they confirmed the illegality of patenting nature. In the 2005 Non-Final rejection of the CDC patent application, the USPTO found the CDC patent on coronavirus isolated from humans unpatentable based on homology with information in the public domain. Their patent on SARS (not on coronavirus), was not only sought illegally. It was rejected as unpatentable in 2006. After appeals and pressure, a patent was granted in 2007 on the SARS component of SARS CoV. In 2015 (after being confirmed illegal by the Supreme Court in 2013) the CDC continued to pay maintenance fees to enforce an illegal patent.
